The Westminster Larger Catechism Q. 32-33

Pastor: How is the grace of God manifested in the second covenant?

People: The grace of God is manifested in the second covenant, in that he freely provideth and offereth to sinners a Mediator, and life and salvation by him; and requiring faith as the condition to interest them in him, promiseth and giveth his Holy Spirit to all his elect, to work in them that faith, with all other saving graces; and to enable them unto all holy obedience, as the evidence of the truth of their faith and thankfulness to God, and as the way which he hath appointed them to salvation. **Pastor:** Was the covenant of grace always administered after one and the same

People: The covenant of grace was not always administered after the same manner, but the administrations of it under the Old Testament were different from those under the New.

Confession of Sin: Psalm 32

- 1 Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- 2 Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
- 3 For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.
- 4 For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.
- 5 I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.
- 6 Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found; surely in the rush of great waters, they shall not reach him.

- 7 You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance.
- 8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.
- 9 Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you.
- 10 Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the LORD.
- 11 Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!
